December 14, 2015

There was an error in last month's bills. The \$37.75 for REA was a credit, not a bill.

Shane Larson (Krahmer) has requested a building permit for a feedlot in Section 22.

Cheryl will cover for the required office hours in January.

The City of Fairmont has sent a letter to United Township Fire Association giving the required 90 days notice for a change in the agreement. It sounds like they are looking at owning all the equipment and having some type of operating agreement with the townships. More information will be coming at a later time. Should the township hire a lawyer? We all agreed it would be the best money spent and suggested Jim Wilson as he worked with us on the agreement with Welcome.

There was some repair work done on the grader in the last month. A hydraulic motor, the turntable motor and the tandem axel lock wire needed repair.

As Dan will be gone most of January, the January meeting was canceled. If needed. A special meeting will be called to deal with the above United Township issues.

Wannarka excavating has replaced the culvert on 150th Ave just north of 70th St. The bill is \$1081.00 and is being paid tonight. Dan will send a bill to New Fashion Pork as agreed at the meeting last spring.

The permit application was discussed again. It was agreed a permit should be required for any work done within the right-of-way of township roads. The form provided by the county needs a few minor changes to fit the township, but will be used mostly as is. The fees will be set at: \$25.00 for a filing fee, with an additional fee of \$200.00 for any open cut into the road bed itself.
