

Rolling Green Town Board Minutes

June 8, 2015

Dan represented Rolling Green Township at the FFMR board meeting on May 26, 2015. The group recommended the townships leave the Welcome equipment fund contribution for 2015 remain at \$2000, but to raise it to \$3000 for each township for 2016. This was approved.

The FFMR group will meet again on July 14, 2015. Representatives from the City of Welcome and the Welcome Fire Department have been invited to this meeting in order to talk about some items prior to the annual Welcome Fire meeting on Tuesday, August 25, 2015 at the Welcome Fire Hall.

MATIT sent a letter stating they would like to conduct a survey of the township buildings and equipment in order to be sure the insurance valuations are correct. The letter stated they would be calling to set up an appointment to do this. If they call Dan's home number no message may be received until the first part of July.

A letter from the state demographer stated the April 1, 2014 population for Rolling Green was 255, with 105 households.

After the heavy rains last weekend, combined with construction of the Krahmer hog facility, led to the need for extensive repair on 110th street. Wannarka Excavating hauled 14 loads of Class 7 material, with 4 of these loads being billed to Krahmer. Krahmer will pay for an additional 2 loads when construction is completed.

The summer short courses are coming up.

Cohrs is hauling gravel on nearby township roads, so they should be getting to ours shortly.

The ditch project on from Vernon Rosenberg and going West has a large number of people opposed to it. The next meeting with the engineer is next week.
