The trees along Pierce Lake Road are getting too big for Brian to get them back far enough with his shredder. Should we hire someone to cut them down to ground level? Brian will check with potential bidders including David Kimmet, Thates, Randy, and Snyder.

The tile permit application sample provided by the county was discussed. The fees need to be clarified with Kevin Peyman. This will be reexamined next month.

The contractors building the new ITC power line will be using the Mescke property site for materials, etc. ITC will maintain the road to the site for the next two years including snow removal and grading.

Royal Redenius and Darrel Klenz have reported washboards on the roads near their places.

Should we be looking at a scarifier blade for the grader? Should we have Manyaska demonstrate with theirs? This will be addressed again before next summer.

The US Fish and Wildlife Service claims they do not have to cut the top swath of the ditches along their property. Vernon Rosenberg feels we should write them a letter requesting they do so. Daniel will check with Kevin Peyman on this. Daniel has an address to send them a letter. Dan will cut the top swath for this fall.
