

# Rolling Green Town Board Minutes

## March 14, 2016

Members present – Dan, Brian, David, Daniel, Todd.

Beginning Balance - \$140,830.93 - Checking \$1,940.06 - Savings \$138,890.87

Deposit this month – \$20,053.46

Paid this month - \$31,411.92

Ending Balance - \$129,472.47 - Checking \$1,581.60 - Savings \$127,890.87

Other Asset accounts - \$24,000 - FFMR \$4,000.00, Grader CD \$20,000

Spring short courses are in March. The one in Windom is Thursday, March 17<sup>th</sup>. We will meet to carpool at Dan's at 7:30 AM.

A work permit was received from Midcontinent Communications to install a new fiber optic cable along 105<sup>th</sup> Street, 160<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and 110<sup>th</sup> Street.

Gravel bids were received from Bettin's and Cohn's. The bid from Cohn's was accepted at \$11.25/ton. The plan is to put on 10 loads per mile on all roads, minus a few areas. This would amount to \$260/load, \$2600/mile, or almost \$91,000 for 34.73 miles.

A number of culverts need attention. The one under Pierce Lake Road by 90<sup>th</sup> Street needs cleaning or replacement. Culverts needing replacement include one at 100<sup>th</sup> Street at 160<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and one on Pierce Lake Road south of the lake. A culvert still needs to be installed on Pierce Lake Road just south of Steve Shane's place. The culvert on 170<sup>th</sup> Avenue at 130<sup>th</sup> Street needs to be checked.

The ditch near Bulfers needs to be cleaned out.

The grader needs some windows.

The ceiling in the town hall has past water damage. It was decided to have Dan install a steel over the old ceiling and eliminate the old wiring above the ceiling. Lights (LED?) will be installed above each voting booth, with new (fluorescent) lights in the large room. Additional outlets will be installed. The outside light above the entrance will also be replaced.

Fairmont has indicated they will put two loads of gravel on the tree dump road.

Brian will put two loads on 150<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

Signs on township roads need to be inventoried and a replacement schedule established. Half the signs were replaced a couple years ago. The rest need to be replaced this year.

All culverts on township roads need to be inventoried and conditions noted.

Right-of-way need to be measured and problem areas staked.

Spencer Olson pushed snow off the township road near his place on 170<sup>th</sup> Avenue, south of 90<sup>th</sup> Street. He will turn in a bill to be paid next month.
