

Rolling Green Town Board Minutes

June 13, 2016

Members present – Dan, Brian, David, Daniel, Todd.

David received a letter from Joe Stauffer complaining about dust created by traffic in front of his place, (attached). Brian discussed the points of the letter with Kevin Peyman. Stauffer cannot stop traffic on the road. The speed limit cannot be lowered without cause, dust does not qualify. Requiring dust control cannot be retroactively applied to current permit holders, but could be added to permits not yet approved. Options for dust control products applied to the road include: Liquid magnesium from S&W Spraying of Sleepy Eye, and dry calcium (the county has some on hand). Dry calcium needs to be applied at 5-6 bags per 100' of road (18' wide) at a cost of \$13/bag. This amounts to about \$500/application for 500-700 feet of road. 3-4 applications would be needed to give season long control. The road also cannot be graded without substantially reducing control.

Last year on 4/15/15 \$20,000 was put into a CD designated for the grader. It was suggested to wait until the gravel bill is paid to make a decision for this year.

MAT membership cards were distributed.

A letter from ITC was received regarding their construction schedule.

Summer Short Courses are coming up soon. We have not attended these in the past.

Election training is Thursday, June 30 from 6-8 PM. A second session is Wednesday, July 6 from 2-4 PM. We will plan to attend the one on the 30th.

A letter from the State Demographer estimates the Rolling Green population as of 4/1/15 is 252. The household estimate is 104.
