February 13, 2017

Three areas were marked for tree/brush removal by Kimmet. He has a \$2500 budget to work with. The 1st priority is the tree on the corner by Redenius's. 2nd is the brush in the ditch near Wells on the road shared with Fraser township. There are a lot of trees growing rapidly by Kings Slough where the north culvert was replaced.

The culvert recently replaced at the north end of Pierce Lake Road needs to be moved deeper than it was. Wannarka Excavating will handle this.
