Daniel is following up from the FEMA meeting on Wednesday. The application process for the flooding that occurred earlier this year is underway with ID numbers being sent in as well as losses documented.

Charles Armburst is being paid \$150 for 1.5 hours of tractor rental for his help in clearing off Pierce Lake Road following the recent wind storm.

Brian and Daniel checked out 170th ave in response to a call from Jim Rosburg saying he is having trouble getting up the road. Wannarka Excavating put 2 loads of class 7 near the south end.

The township mileage of 34.73 miles of roads was certified as correct.

A conditional use permit for an auto shop in Section 21 was approved by the county.

The Ag Credit of \$1619.96 was received from the state. Capitol Credits of \$53.65 were received from REA.

The beacon light on the grader is obsolete and the bulb may be unavailable. Daniel will follow up on this. Daniel will also follow up on getting a tire from the county they no longer need for a spare for the grader.

The wing needs to be put on, but the roads need grading once or twice yet before this is done.
